Manjari Nehru Kaul, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner resigned from the post on Director of M/s SRS Ltd. on 06.02.2017 (Annexure P-3) and thereafter he had no concern with the said firm or any companies of the group. Hence, it has been prayed that directions be issued to the official respondents not to call the petitioner time and again on the pretext of investigation of cases which stand registered against M/s SRS Ltd. and other group companies. Further prayer has been made that an advance notice of at least 10 days be given to the petitioner in case he is required for the investigation in any of the FIRs lodged against M/s SRS Ltd. In addition to the aforementioned prayers, a prayer has also been made to direct the respondents not to take any coercive steps against him.

Heard.

It needs to be emphasized that it is within the exclusive domain of the Police to carry out investigation as and when a complaint with respect to the alleged commission of any offence is brought to its notice. This Court cannot, however, enter the realm of investigation.

In the circumstances, after hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the material on record, this Court is not inclined to invoke its inherent jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.PC. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
