The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.15 dated 01.03.2020, under Sections 379-B, 353, 186, 224, 225, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ajitwal, Moga, District Moga.

The coordinate Bench of this court on 03.02.2021 had passed the following order:-

“The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Notice of motion for 27.04.2021.

To be heard along with CRM-M-44280-2020 (Darshan Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab).

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Faily Singh,

states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 03.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
