The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.07 dated 21.01.2021, under Sections 15 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused. It is alleged that total recovery of 45 kgs of poppy husk in 03 plastic bags containing 15 kgs each were recovered from a car in which co-accused namely Jasbir Singh and Kashmira Singh were travelling.

This Court, by the order dated 03.02.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jagroop Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 03.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
