The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.348 dated 28.12.2019, under Sections 201, 406, 420, 500 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court on 28.01.2020 had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the allegation against the petitioner is that she had conspired with other accused to defraud the complainant of cash and jewellery. He has further submitted that there is no allegation of entrustment of any money or jewellery to the present petitioner.

Notice of motion for 30.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing

personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ajit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 28.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
