Present petition has been filed seeking quashing of FIR No.0039 dated 16.01.2019 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Camp Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as of now, the police has already come to the conclusion that the untraceable report is to be presented in the present FIR but the same has not been presented by the police so far and that too without any valid justification. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is not pressing this petition for quashing but only prays that a time bound direction be given to the respondent-State to present the report, they intend to file keeping in view the investigation already undertaken, so that no prejudice is caused to the petitioner in any manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that he has instructions that the report, that is intended to be filed by the Investigating Agency, will be filed before the competent Court of law within a period of 8 weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said undertaking, no other grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and therefore, the petitioner does not wish to press this petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

As the main case has been disposed of as not pressed, applications i.e. CRM-3317-2020, CRM-3318-2020, CRM-26849-2021 and CRM-26851-2021 also stand disposed of.
