Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.164 dated 22.09.2020 under Sections 379, 411, 413, 473 IPC registered at Police Station Cit South Moga, District Moga.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he used to commit theft of motorcycles and after affixing forged number plates, he used to sell the same to public.
