Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3, to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of private respondents.

2. Petitioner No.1 – Renu, aged 28 years and petitioner No.2 – Amit Kumar, aged 30 years, who appeared in-person, submit that they have got married on 1st February, 2021, against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 7. It has been further submitted that the private respondents are threatening to interfere in the marital life of the petitioners. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2–Senior Superintendent of Police, UT, Chandigarh to look into the representation dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-5) *qua* threat perception, if any, and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is
