Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the claim made on the online portal for change of department from the post of Peon in the Department of Town and Country Planning, Haryana to the post of Animal Attendant in the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Haryana. The said claim is based on the strength of the letter dated 24.06.2019 (Annexure P-3) whereby respondent No.1 had offered one time opportunity to change the department/post of newly recruited persons in Group-D posts.

It is the case of the petitioner that in pursuance of the said letter, he had applied within the prescribed period vide application No.480587245 (Annexure P-4) and thereafter also, he had filed representation dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) with respondent No.1, bringing to its notice that his application has not been acted upon whereas the other employees have been appointed after changing their department.

The said process be completed within a period of 6 weeks from the receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case there is any legal impediment in allowing the said request, a reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
