Through this revision petition, the petitioners-Punjab State Electricity Board assails the correctness of the order passed by the learned trial court on 23.03.2016, while allowing an application under Order 33 Rule 1 CPC. The suit has been filed by a Private Limited Company. It has come on record that the Company is no more commercially sound and as per the report submitted, the Company did not had sufficient property to pay the amount of court fee. Thus, the court, in its discretion, permitted the plaintiff (respondent) to sue as an indigent person.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that on the order of the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, the respondent-Company was paid a sum of Rs.19,00,000/- in the year 2006-07. The suit in question was filed in the year 2002. The status of the plaintiff is to be examined on the date of the institution of the suit.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has failed to draw the attention of the

court to any such substantive error in the order passed. Hence, no ground to interfere in exercise of the revisional jurisdiction of this Court is made out.

Dismissed.
