This is a petition for regular bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.197 dated 01.10.2017, under Sections 302, 201 & 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for 3 years, 4 months and 9 days till date, which is more than the period undergone by the co-accused, namely, Darshan Singh, who was granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-7836-2020 on 24.11.2020 vide Annexure P-4, since it had come on record that no poison was detected in the body of the deceased as submitted by Ld. State Counsel in that case.

[3]. Considering the overall circumstances of the case and treating the case of petitioner on the same parity as that of his above-named co-accused, the prayer of the petitioner for his release on regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and

conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
