Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner has challenged the order dated 21.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) by which the claim of the petitioner for starting a new course of Bachelors in Pharmacy has been rejected being time barred but, the petitioner restricts the claim for deciding the legal notice (Annexure P-7) dated 25.01.2021 wherein, the petitioner has brought to the notice of the University certain discrepancies, which has occurred in the present case as two authorities i.e. the University and the Pharmacy Council of India have prescribed two different last dates for applying for starting new course due to which confusion has been created.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a direction is given to the respondent-University to decide the legal notice (Annexure P-7) wherein, all these facts have been mentioned.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Nilesh Bhardwaj, Advocate, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1. He has no objection with regard to prayer of the petitioner for deciding the legal notice (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner by passing a speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being raised by the petitioner in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-University to decide the legal notice submitted by the petitioner Annexure P-7 dated 25.01.2021 within a period of fifteen days from today. The order so passed, will be conveyed to the petitioner immediately thereafter.
