Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

The petitioners state that they are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. The marriage certificate, evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-3. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 29.01.2021, Annexure P-4 to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur-respondent No.2, to decide the representation of the petitioners, dated 29.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is

perceived.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
