This is a petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.291 dated 15.11.2019 registered under Sections 382, 341, 323, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

On 28.01.2020, when this case came up for hearing before this Court, the following order was passed:-

“Present: Mr.Rajesh Duhan, Advocate for the petitioner.

It is stated that basically the dispute between the parties is of civil nature and all the injuries are simple and further the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 26.3.2020.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation by contacting the Investigating Officer within five days from today and render all sort of cooperation. The petitioner is to surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer, if he

has got one, otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard. If in the meanwhile, he is arrested, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer.

28.01.2020”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhjinder Singh has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation in this case and that the alleged injuries are simple in nature.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.01.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
