The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.,
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0001 dated
05.01.2019 under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police
Station Women Cell, District SAS Nagar.

As per report received from the Mediation Centre, the parties
have failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to
order dated 04th February 2019 passed by the coordinate Bench of this
Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Nirdosh Singh
states that the petitioner has the joined investigation. He submits that though

the complainant did produce certain bills in support of their case with respect to jewellery items given by the complainant at the time of marriage in 2016 however, all the other bills which were produced by the complainant were much after the marriage of the parties i.e., bills of 2017 and 2018 qua jewellery and bill qua the furniture was of the year 2019.

Learned State counsel submits that as far as the jewellery (gold chain and gold ring) which was purchased in the year 2016 and qua which bills were given by the complainant, the all stood recovered.

Heard.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04th February 2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) CrPC.
