The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C.
for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 349 dated 11.11.2020,
registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at
Police Station Jhabal, district Tarn Taran.

The petitioner is being prosecuted for having assaulted the
complainant as a result whereof he received grievous injuries.

On 05.02.2021, after considering the pleas raised on behalf of
the petitioner, this Court issued notice and in the meanwhile, subject to the
petitioner's joining investigation he was ordered to be released on ad
interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

On 20.08.2021, learned State counsel informed the Court that
the petitioner had not joined the investigation. In the interest of justice, the

hearing of the matter was adjourned to 06.09.2021 and the petitioner was granted another opportunity to join investigation.

On 06.09.2021 learned State counsel again informed this Court that the petitioner had not joined the investigation. On such statement the hearing of the matter was adjourned to today with a direction to the petitioner to join investigation before D.S.P., Tarn Taran.

Today also, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

The above statement is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Dismissed.
