1. This writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the alleged final electoral list published on 29.1.2021 (Annexure P-3) which is the 4th list after inviting objections and the name of many voters of the wards have been deliberately deleted and outsider voters have been added.

2. Today learned State counsel after going through all the lists has pointed out that even though what the counsel for the petitioner and counsel for respondents No. 3 to 6 were saying seemed to be contradictory but in reality there is no contradiction. As per him, it is correct that in the draft list published on 5.12.2020 the name of the petitioner No.2 was mentioned in the voter list of ward No.13 but when the final list was published on 5.1.2021 petitioner No.2 was reflected as residents of ward No.10 . Thereafter, in the list of 14.1.2021 petitioner

No.2 was shown in ward No. 13 but thereafter, detailed enquiry was directed to be held and on that detailed enquiry it was transpired that he was a resident of ward No.10 and that is why his name has been shown as a voter of ward No.10.

3. In this view of the matter, we do not find any reason to further proceed with the writ petition. Of course, the petitioners would be at liberty to file election petition on the ground that their names were illegally removed from their ward and the same would be decided as per law.

4. Petition stands disposed of.

5. Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
