The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeks directions for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner w.e.f. from the date his juniors have been regularized i.e. 19/22.11.2003 and to release all consequential benefits or alternatively prayer is made to decide the legal notice dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-6).

The petitioner is working as part time Class-IV employee in the Education Department since 01.12.1997. It is his grouse that respondents No.4 & 5 were appointed after him on 10.07.2000 and 01.04.1998, respectively and were regularized vide order dated 17.10.2013 (Annexure P-2).

Mr. RKS Brar, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

Keeping in view the limited relief which is sought and the fact that decision making is still pending, the present writ petition is disposed off with the direction to respondent No.3/competent authority to take a

decision on the said legal notice dated 25.11.2020 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, the relief is to be declined, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner forthwith.
