This petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for appropriate direction to respondent No.1 and 2 to set up a committee to inquire the entire matter and order registration of FIR for the fraud done at the hands of contractor in connivance of the official of MC, Kaithal.

Learned counsel contends that the petitioner had already given complaints (Annexure P-7 and P-8) to the Secretary, Municipal Committee, Kalayat and District Municipal Commissioner, Kaithal, wherein it is alleged that the contractor obtained the work by fraud and the work was executed by violating the terms and conditions. He submits that despite issuing the legal notice also, no action is being taken by the official respondents, therefore, the necessary directions be issued.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that the petitioner is a social activist and was not connected with the process of awarding the contract or with the execution of the work carried out by the

Contractor.

Considering the above background, nature of the prayer and the fact that the petitioner is stranger to the alleged contract, this Court is not inclined to exercise the extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
