Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved seeking directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty to the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 18 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 27.01.2021 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), to look into and decide representation dated 27.01.2021 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
