AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court, praying for quashing of demand notice dated 05.12.2019 (Annexure P-41), whereby payment of external development charges/internal development charges to the tune of ₹35,13,166/- has been raised by the respondents in respect of Plot No.367-A, Sector 3, Extension HSIIDC, Industrial Estate, Karnal, although all the dues on account of EDC/IDC i.e. ₹40,45,210/- have been deposited by the petitioner but still till date neither any sewerage facility or electricity connection has been provided to him.

What transpired is that highlighting the said aspect, the petitioner has served a legal notice dated 12.08.2020 (Annexure P-42) and

thereafter a reminder dated 21.12.2020 (Annexure P-43), which have not been responded to till date by the respondents. Counsel for the petitioner asserts that inaction on the part of the respondents is not sustainable and, he, therefore, prays that atleast all the details be provided to the petitioner as to how the amount for which notice has been received stands arrived at and as to how the amount deposited by the petitioner has been adjusted by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents, Mr. Ankur Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, asserts that the grievance of the petitioner, as highlighted in the legal notice dated 12.08.2020 (Annexure P-42), will be responded to at an early date.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Managing Director, Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation, Panchkula-respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.08.2020 (Annexure P-42) within a period of two months from today by providing either the personal hearing or through virtual mode to the petitioner. In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be provided to her within a further period of two months.
