Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.316 dated 21.11.2020 for the offences under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case in hand as he was not present at the time when the alleged fake appointment letter was handed over to the complainant. He further submits that in the complaint, the complainant had alleged that after he had deposited the money in the account of the petitioner, same had been handed over to Amanpreet Kaur and Amit, however, these two persons have not been named as an accused in the case in hand.

Heard.

Prima facie there are serious allegations levelled against the petitioner of duping the complainant of an amount of Rs.2 lakhs for getting him the job of an attendant in PGI, Chandigarh and even as per the FIR,

Rs.2 lakhs were deposited in the account of the petitioner for the said work. The deposit of Rs.2 Lakhs also stands admitted by the petitioner though his stand is that it was handed over to Amanpreet Kaur and Amrit and not retained by him.

Heard.

No ground is made out to extend the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the wake of the allegations leveled against him. Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
