AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Mr. Mohit Dhull – petitioner No.1, son of Shri Ramesh Kumar, submits that the nomination papers of the petitioners have been submitted today and therefore, in this regard, the present writ petition has rendered infructuous. However, he contends that the petitioners have received threats from the members of the other political parties and therefore, are feeling unsafe and they have also doubt that the elections would not be held in fair and free manner. He further states that the petitioners would submit a detailed representation highlighting therein their apprehensions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, today itself and pray for a direction to the said officer to consider the same and take action thereon.

In the light of the statement made by petitioner No.1, the present writ petition with regard to the prayer of the petitioners relating to the filing of the nomination papers having been rendered infructuous and is

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disposed of accordingly.

However, as regards the grievances of the petitioners relatable to the threats to their lives and liberty as well as apprehension with regard to hold of free and fair elections, let the petitioners submit their representation(s) to the Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur as well as the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, highlighting their apprehensions, if any. If such representation(s) is made, the same shall be considered and disposed of within a period of three days from the date of submission of the said representation(s). In case some substance is found therein, appropriate steps in accordance with law be taken.
