The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his prayer be confined to grant of interim bail in view of ratio laid down in **Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 953 (DB)** till receipt of FSL report.

Learned counsel for the the petitioner submits that as per allegations, 1800 Tramadol capsules were allegedly recovered from the plastic bag kept by the co-accused Vishal

Singh as pillion rider of the motorcycle. Petitioner was driving the motorcycle. Vishal Singh filed CRM-M No.5942 of 2021 and the same was decided on 16.02.2021 in view of ratio laid down in **Inderjeet Singh's case (supra)**, thereby directing to release the co-accused on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court till receipt of FSL report.

For the reasons recorded in the case of co-accused, the petitioner is also directed to be released on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court. Interim bail is granted specifically till receipt of FSL report. On receipt of FSL report, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Court and thereafter, he would be at liberty to seek his legal remedies in accordance with law. Violation of any terms and conditions would entail in seeking cancellation of bail by the prosecution in accordance with law.
