The petitioners seek a direction to the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, to expeditiously decide their revision in ROR No. 117/2014-2015.

The petitioners' suit for declaration and consequential permanent injunction filed against the Gram Panchayat, Fatehpur, Tehsil and District Jhajjar, was dismissed by the Collector, Jhajjar, *vide* order dated 31.01.2012. Their appeal against the said order before the Commissioner, Rohtak Division, Rohtak, was dismissed on 26.06.2014. Thereupon, they filed the subject revision before the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, in the year 2014. While so, notice dated 08.01.2021 is stated to have been issued by the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat, Fatehpur, proposing to dispossess the petitioners. The petitioners claim to have filed a stay application in the pending revision on 18.01.2021 but complain that no orders have been passed thereon.

They also point out that their revision is pending since the last six years and is yet to be decided. It is in these circumstances that they sought a direction for early disposal of their revision.

Today, Mr. Sandeep Singh Maan, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, having ascertained the factual position would inform this Court that the petitioners' stay application in the pending revision has been taken on file and would be taken up for consideration within ten days.

As the statutory revisionary authority is seized of the matter, it would be appropriate that the stay application filed therein be addressed in the first instance owing to the urgency expressed by the petitioners.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, to take up the petitioners' stay application in ROR No. 117/2014-2015 and pass appropriate orders thereon expeditiously and in any event, not later than ten days. The Financial Commissioner shall also endeavour to dispose of the main revision expeditiously, as the same has been pending on his file for over half a decade.

No order as to costs.
