The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to conclude the investigation and submit the final report in case bearing FIR No. 154 dated 23.07.2020 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 326, 452, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sri Hargobindpur, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur in a time bound manner as the accused-respondents are making efforts to tamper with the prosecution evidence and threatening the petitioner party.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that before approaching this Court, petitioner submitted a representation dated 23.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) to the official respondents for concluding the investigation. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into his representation sent on 23.01.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala – respondent No.2 to examine the representation (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation (Annexure P-4) be communicated to respondent No.2 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
