By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail' upon FIR No. 0004, having been registered at Police Station Division No. 8, Jalandhar alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and Section 420 of the IPC.

Learned State counsel (on instructions), submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 11.02.2020 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 7 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
