**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.481 dated 08.08.2020 under Sections 376, 323, 506 read with 34 IPC (Later Section 376 IPC was deleted and Sections 325 and 307 IPC were added) registered at Police Station Samalkha, Panipat.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that present FIR was registered on a complaint given by Jyoti who is wife of the petitioner. It is further submitted that even on an earlier occasion i.e. on 14.6.2020 one cross FIR No.337 under Sections 323, 498-A read with Section 34 IPC, 376 read with Section 511 IPC was also registered by the same complainant Jyoti against the petitioner and in-laws and another FIR No.338 under Sections 323, 452, 506 read with Section 34 IPC was registered by Rajinder Singh (father of the petitioner).

Learned senior counsel relies upon a compromise effected between the parties in which wife/complainant namely Jyoti in the present FIR as well as in FIR No.337 has stated that she had married with petitioner

Learned State counsel assisted by the complainant could not dispute the factual position. However, it is submitted that apart from the complainant, her parents are also injured victim. Learned State counsel further submitted that petitioner is in custody for the last about more than one year and the investigation is complete.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, concerned.
