Appellants - Kulvir Singh and Lakhwinder Singh, who had been convicted and sentenced by learned Sessions Judge, Moga vide judgment and order of sentence dated 18.2.2020 had filed CRA-S-1108-2020 and CRA-S-1156-2020, respectively through Sh.Gaurav Rana, Advocate. The date mentioned on the grounds of appeal in both the appeals is 19.3.2020.

Interestingly, subsequently two more appeals i.e. CRA-S-101-2021 and CRA-S-105-2021 (present appeals) have been filed on their behalf through other counsel, namely, Sh.Monty Goel, Advocate on 1.2.2021 and 4.2.2021.

Though status of the cases should have been checked up before filing second appeals for the same appellants/convicts, nevertheless only one appeal by each appellant/convict can proceed.

Sh.Gaurav Rana, Advocate, who had filed CRA-S-1108-2020 and CRA-S-1156-2020 is not present. However, Mr.Monty Goel, Advocate, who had filed CRA-S-101-2021 and CRA-S-105-2021 present appeals, is present. He states that his presence be marked on behalf of appellants in CRA-S-1108-2020 and CRA-S-1156-2020. He has been asked to file vakalatnama in his favour in CRA-S-1108-2020 and CRA-S-1156-2020 in the Registry. He further submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present appeals i.e. CRA-S-101-2021 and CRA-S-105-2021.

Permission to withdraw CRA-S-101-2021 and CRA-S-105-2021 is granted.

CRA-S-101-2021 and CRA-S-105-2021 are dismissed as withdrawn.
