This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioner for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing official respondents to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 10 and to take action against the private respondents in case FIR No.109 dated 25.10.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City-2, Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that in this behalf, petitioner has already made representation on 24.11.2020 to Director General of Police, Punjab, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Saurav Khurana, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, District Mansa, to look into and decide representation dated 24.11.2020 (Annexure P/2) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
