By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.14, dated 18.01.2021, having been registered at Police Station City-I, Sangrur, District Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 & 471 of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 09.02.2021, a reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Sangrur, on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab, has been filed in Court today, which is ordered to be taken on record. A copy thereof has been given to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that though of course in the reply of the DSP, Sangrur, it has been 'formally stated' that the petition be dismissed, now as per instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, it has been stated that the petitioner had joined investigation and pursuant to the orders of this Court she was admitted to bail and that presently at least her custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, she would be given 10 days' notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon her.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner of lack of proper investigation, he would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as per law.
