The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gulneet Singh Khurana, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar-Rural has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in the Registry which is taken on record.

In the Status report it has been mentioned that respondents No.4 and 5, who are parents of the petitioner No.1, Harmanpreet Kaur, have stated that they have no objection in marriage of the petitioners and they can live anywhere and they have no complaint in it. As such, on the basis of statements of the petitioners and respondents No.4 and 5 and as per report submitted in this regard by the SHO P.S. Kathunangal, Amritsar-Rural, the petitioners have no threat from the respondents No. 4 to 6. However, the petitioners have been advised by SHO P.S. Kathunangal, Amritsar-Rural that if, in future, they have any

kind of threat or grievance, they may approach the local police and their grievance would be redressed accordingly.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners do not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.
