B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the Contempt Petition with liberty to pursue the matter before the learned Executing Court and directions being issued to the learned Executing Court to decide the execution proceedings at the earliest.
3. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. As regards the prayer of the petitioner for issuance of directions, it needs noticing here that the petitioner has come up in contempt proceedings and not against any proceedings pending before the learned Executing Court, therefore, no such direction can be issued to the learned Executing Court. However, it needs no mention that in the eventuality of the petitioner approaching the executing court, the learned Executing Court shall take out proceedings in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
