The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 241 dated 24.09.2020 under Sections 323, 325, 506, 379, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Patti District Tarn Taran.

On 09.02.2021, notice of motion was issued on the premise that the offences except the offence under Section 379 IPC are bailable in nature. As regards the offence under

Section 379 IPC, there was no specific allegation against the petitioner. Interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant has received serious injuries including fractures on the lower limbs and by virtue of his assignment, he is totally incapacitated to drive the vehicle. Offence under Section 325 IPC is attracted which is bailable in nature.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, submits that in compliance of order dated 09.02.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and his presence is no more required for any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 09.02.2021 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
