The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in cross case bearing GD No. 32 dated 12.06.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 34, 326 IPC in FIR No. 66 dated 11.06.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 34, IPC registered at Police Station Amargarh District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are

not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 30.01.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
