The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 235 dated 16.11.2020, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No. 2, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that the brother of the complainant had committed suicide, as he was threatened by the petitioner and other family members. The petitioner is the mother of the girl with whom the deceased was allegedly in a relationship. He also contends that the allegations in the FIR would not make out a *prima facie* case for the commission of offence punishable under Section 306 IPC. There is no suicide note. He further contends that the matter has also been compromised. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P2.

Learned counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

This Court, by order dated 09.02.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 09.02.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
