The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.172 dated 24.12.2020 registered under Sections 323, 34, 377, 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, District Kaithal.

By virtue of the order dated 9.2.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

In pursuance to the order dated 6.4.2021, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the documents, which would show that

the petitioner has already filed divorce petition, which is pending adjudication. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and the same is likely to be concluded and the challan is also likely to be presented.
