The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The plaintiff (petitioner herein) assails the correctness of the orders passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Batala, on 19.04.2018 and 13.09.2018, respectively.

On 19.04.2018, while allowing the application under Order 1 Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, the Court permitted Kanchan Bhatia to be impleaded as defendant. An application filed by the plaintiff not to permit the newly impleaded defendant to file written statement was dismissed vide an order dated 13.09.2018.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner has fairly informed the Court that the newly impleaded defendant has already filed a written statement and all the parties have concluded their affirmative evidence.

It has been stated that the suit is now fixed for rebuttal and arguments.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no further order is required to be passed.
