The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

In response to notice, official respondents No.1 to 3 have filed status report by way of affidavit of DIG-Cum-SSP, Sirsa, wherein it has been *inter alia* deposited as under:-

“3. That during the enquiry proceedings, Petitioners Ajay & Roopa Kumari as well as Shri Bhoop Singh son of Shri Makhan Lal (father of petitioner no.2) have suffered their statement before the Police that now

both Ajay and Roopa Kumari are living as husband and wife in the house at Prem Nagar, Gali No.6, Sirsa and they have no apprehension of any kind to their life. They have also specifically stated that parents of the petitioner Roopa Kumari have no objection out of this love marriage of the petitioners. Petitioners Ajay and Roopa Kumari also stated that they will have no objection, if the protection petition filed by them before the Hon'ble High Court is dismissed by the Court.”

In view of the above development, no orders are called for.

Petition stands dismissed.
