[1]. Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.209 dated 30.10.2020 registered under Section 22-B of the NDPS Act at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

[2]. As per allegations, 1800 Tramadol capsules were recovered from the plastic bag. The case was registered against the petitioner and co-accused.

[3]. Admittedly, FSL report has not been received so far. Petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2020. Petitioner is not involved in any other case.

[4]. In view of ratio laid down in **Inderjeet Singh@ Laddi and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 953,**

petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court. Interim bail is granted specifically till the receipt of the FSL report. On receipt of FSL report, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Court. Petitioner would be at liberty to seek his remedy in accordance with law.

[5]. In case of any violation of terms and conditions, the prosecution would be at liberty to seek cancellation of bail in accordance with law.
