The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This petition is filed seeking direction to private respondents not to interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents.

Notice of motion was issued on 10.2.2021 to the official respondents. It was directed that the police official not below the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police should record the statements of petitioners.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satwant submits that the statements of petitioners were recorded by the ACP Central Amritsar. The petitioners have stated there that as on day there is no threat perception and they do not want facility of safe home.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of statements made no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. However, liberty is sought to approach police authorities in case need so arises in future.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
