Petition herein is under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking, *inter alia*, issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the benefit of annual grade increments along with all consequential benefits to the petitioner against the post of Clerk with effect from the year 2013 to 2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner submitted a representation 03.08.2020 (Annexure P-8) followed by another representation dated 22.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) but the same have not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, at this stage, if a final decision is taken by the respondents on the representations dated 03.08.2020 and 22.10.2020 (Annexures P-8 and P-9).

4. Learned counsel relies on an order passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.6750 of 2017 decided on 27.01.2020 contained at Annexure P-11.

5. Notice of motion.
6. Ms. Mamta Talwar, DAG, Haryana on service of advance copy of the petition joins the proceedings and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Haryana.
7. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.
8. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the representation dated 03.08.2020 (Annexure P-8) read with representation dated 22.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and decide the same, by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law.
9. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from today.
10. In case any favourable order is passed, then benefit thereof be accorded to the petitioner within a period of 3 months thereafter.
11. Disposed of accordingly.
