By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail', upon FIR No. 169 having been registered at Police Station Phagwara, District Kapurthala, on 11.05.2020, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 326/323/148/149/188 of the IPC.

Despite notice of motion having been issued on 11.02.2021 in this case, with it ordered that this petition be heard along with CRM-M-3583-2021, with an interim order passed in the same terms in that case, learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioner in this case (Manpreet Singh) has not joined investigation.
