This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 135 dated 07.11.2019 under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Longowal, District Sangrur, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner was apprehended and 300 tablets of CLOVIDOL 100 SR and ALPRASAFE 0.5 were recovered from him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner vide order dated 17.01.2020 passed in **CRM-M-3350-2019** has been granted concession of interim bail awaiting the report of FSL.

In the aforesaid order, it was clearly observed that the petitioner will furnish an undertaking before the trial Court/Illaqu Magistrate along with his bail/surety bonds and will surrender before the trial Court on receiving the FSL report.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits

that now FSL report has been received and instead of surrendering before the trial Court and applying for fresh bail, the petitioner is moving his anticipatory bail which is not maintainable.

Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Accordingly, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.

The petitioner, if so advised, may comply with the order dated 17.01.2020.
