Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.121 dated 17.11.2019, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3, 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 (Sections 376, 450, 506 IPC and Section 6 POCSO Act, 2012 added later on), at Police Station Zira, District Ferozepur but later on summoned under Sections 363, 366-A, 450 and 120-B IPC on application under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.. She approached this Court for grant of anticipatory bail by way of this petition and vide order dated 10.02.2021, the Court directed her to surrender before the trial Court within a week and subject to the same, she was to be admitted on interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 10.02.2021, petitioner has surrendered before the Court on 12.02.2021 and she has been admitted to bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Shamsheer Singh, affirms the contention submitted by counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 10.02.2021, is made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
