GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.526 dated 13.09.2019 at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad, under Sections 147/149/323/452/506 IPC (Sections 25 of the Arms Act and Section 379-B IPC stand deleted).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the instant FIR came to be lodged under some misunderstanding, which has since been resolved amongst the parties. It has been submitted that the petitioner has already filed a separate petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, which is still pending and that the statements of the parties qua the factum of compromise have already been recorded before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.

3. The aforesaid position is not disputed by the learned State counsel, who has received instructions to this effect from SI Rajender.
4. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties, the petition is accepted and the petitioner, in the event of arrest, is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
