Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case the alleged recovery was effected from the co-accused and that was also non-commercial in nature i.e. 121.8 grams of Clovidol SR 100 and there is no other evidence to link the petitioner with the present offence except for the disclosure statement of co-accused. She has further submitted that on 11.2.2021, interim protection was granted by this Court and in pursuance of the same, the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process. She has further submitted that inadvertently Section 29 of NDPS Act could not be mentioned in the headnote of the petition because the same was added later on and this fact regarding adding of Section 29 of the NDPS Act has also been admitted by the learned State counsel when this Court had granted interim protection to

the petitioner on 11.2.2021.

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, has stated that in pursuance of order dated 11.2.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigation process and is not required for custodial investigation. He has further submitted that he has no objection in case Section 29 of the NDPS Act is added in the headnote of the petition.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed and interim order dated 11.2.2021, is hereby made absolute. In the headnote of the petition, Section 29 of the NDPS Act, shall be deemed to be included.

Since the main case has been disposed of, misc. applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
