The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.155 dated 16.05.2020, under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, district Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although it is alleged that 40 litres of illicit liquor was recovered from the house of the petitioner but she was not present and has been falsely implicated.

Issue notice to the respondent.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Amar Ashok Pathak, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and upon instructions from ASI Rajpal Singh, states that the petitioner is also involved in 04 other cases.

Heard through video conferencing.

The petitioner is stated to be involved in four other cases and recovery of 40 litres of illicit liquor has been effected from her house, I do not find it appropriate to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.
