Copy of reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Shahabad, Kurukshetra, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 27.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kurukshetra, vide which an application filed by the petitioner seeking permission to go abroad for his business purpose has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner, who is a Director of the Company, intends to visit U.K. for the business purposes. Earlier also vide order dated 07.02.2020 (Annexure P-11) passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner was granted liberty for two months to visit abroad, which had been extended till 27.10.2020 and during the said period, the petitioner had never misused the aforesaid concession.

At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the flights from India to U.K. are still inoperative.

Faced with the situation, the learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one as and when the flights from India to U.K. stand operating.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
