1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48, dated 26.12.2019, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 of IPC at Police Station Women-II, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

2. By an order dated 29.01.2021, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner and directed him to join investigation.

3. Pursuant to order dated 29.01.2021, petitioner has joined investigation. However, on that very date, an offer was made by the petitioner to settle the dispute for an amount of Rs.17 lakhs subject to the condition that minor child is handed over to him, which is not acceptable to the complainant at all.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State does not dispute the fact that petitioner has joined investigation.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 29.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
