Petitioners, namely, Vikas Kumar @ Pawan, Ravi and Sonu @ Sonu Ram have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.422 dated 11.10.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 325 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has argued that the alleged incident took place on 08.10.2020, whereas the FIR was registered on 11.10.2020. The petitioners are in custody since 15.10.2020. There is no specific attribution of injury to the petitioners-accused invoking offence under Section 307 IPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurbachan Singh, has argued that the injured in the case remained admitted in hospital

for 10 days and 3 injuries were given on the head of the injured-victim. The doctor has opined the injury as dangerous to life.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

There is no dispute that the alleged incident had taken place on 08.10.2020, whereas the FIR was registered on 11.10.2020. Which of the petitioner has caused injury invoking the offence under Section 307 IPC is a matter to be established during the trial. Since the petitioners being in custody since 15.10.2020 and the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioners on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as any expression of opinion on the merits of the case. The trial Court shall decide the case without being influenced with these observations in any manner.
